Who is the course for?

University-qualified health professionals: kinesiology and physiotherapy, dentistry, medicine (ophthalmology, ENT, neurology, orthopedics, pediatrics and physical medicine), optics and optometry, university-level podiatry, occupational therapy, speech and language therapy, and related professions.

Admission: a university degree is required; students are not eligible. Basic skills in Google Classroom, Zoom and presentation tools are necessary.

What will you develop?

- 01** Assess postural control using an organized clinical sequence.
- 02** Integrate visual, vestibular, proprioceptive, plantar and stomatognathic information.
- 03** Identify potential dysregulating factors and interpret clinical and stabilometric findings.
- 04** Form clinical hypotheses and interdisciplinary treatment strategies.
- 05** Communicate findings and establish consultation or referral criteria.

Teaching team

Lead instructor: Lic. Santiago Crucci Vázquez. Degree in Kinesiology and Physiotherapy from UBA (2000), with residency and chief residency at Hospital Carlos G. Durand (2001-2005). He lives and practices in Barcelona. Associate Professor of Physiotherapy at the University of Lleida and Physiotherapy UB-UdG (EUSES), and lecturer in the University of Barcelona Master's in Clinical Posturology. Honorary founder of APA; member of the Paris Committee for Standardization in Clinical Stabilometry and Posture Lab.

Associate faculty: APA's interdisciplinary kinesiology and dentistry team is responsible for practical activities and clinical case follow-up.

From foundations to clinical practice

Blended learning. 10 academic videos, one welcome video, 7 live online sessions and 4 in-person meetings in Buenos Aires, totaling 10 days of practice. Live sessions are recorded for review. Virtual classroom and materials remain available for 24 months.

01 Introduction and neurophysiology

Definition, history, schools and applications of clinical posturology. Neurophysiological and physical-mathematical foundations of postural control, dynamic systems and the tonic postural system. Interdisciplinary practice.

02 Sensory systems

Plantar, visual, stomatognathic and vestibular systems. Postural deficiency syndrome, sensory integration and reweighting.

03 Assessment and clinical reasoning

History-taking, postural and morphostatic assessment, flash examination, tone, balance and stability. Bucket test, Maddox, cover test, near point of convergence, podopelvic test, TEPU, Fukuda, postural Romberg and Bassani. Parallel feet, proprioception, prioritizing findings and clinical hypotheses.

04 Neurosensory treatment

Treatment approaches and planning. Podoposturology: testing, design and fabrication of postural insoles. Active prisms: foundations, indications, design and preparation of glasses. Intraoral neurosensory stimulation devices and oral stimuli. Testing, retesting, follow-up and discharge criteria.

05 Clinical cases and follow-up

Informed consent and case presentation requirements. Assessment and treatment cases with faculty feedback, patient follow-up and review of therapeutic decisions.

06 Integration and stabilometry

Integration of assessment and treatment. Force and pressure platforms; stabilometric recording and interpretation. Vestibular system, graviceptors, limbic system and postural control in dyslexia.

07 Assessment and completion

Assessment of the two mandatory practical assignments, case integration, course closing and certificate presentation.

How learning takes place

Demonstrations and clinical test videos, guided in-person practice, reading materials, case analysis and faculty follow-up. Independent study is devoted to preparing clinical cases and assessments.

International participation: online activities can be attended from other countries. In-person practice takes place in Buenos Aires; venue to be confirmed. Check that dates are confirmed before arranging travel.

Certification and enrollment

Blended learning. Certifies 240 total hours with a final examination.

Successful completion requires attendance at in-person seminars 1 and 2 and passing two mandatory practical assignments.

Tuition and benefits

Total tuition: USD 1,500.

Deposit: USD 250, deducted from the total. Check availability before paying.

Benefits: 5% for APA members + 5% when reserving through December 31, 2026, inclusive. Gift: Online Course Foundations of Postural Control.

Payment methods

Bank transfer or deposit in Argentine pesos at Banco Nación's selling exchange rate on the payment date, or in US dollars. Card payment through Mercado Pago with a 10% surcharge. From abroad: PayPal via a link provided by the Administrative Office.

Ask about a payment plan.

The balance must be paid in full before the second in-person meeting begins in July.

Cancellation policy: If you cannot attend an in-person class for any reason, the amount paid will not be refunded.

Missed payment commitments: Failure to meet payment commitments results in removal from the WhatsApp group and Classroom and prevents further participation in the course from the date of non-payment.

The course requires a minimum of 15 participants.

Assessment kits: additional cost

Some postural and plantar assessment kits and prisms will need to be purchased for practical work and patient assessment. APA will explain which items are needed and how and when to purchase them.
